The meeting was opened at 6:09pm with 45 people present. President Bob Rutan started the meeting with the flag salute and a moment of silence for all our servicemen and women and to their families. Treasurer Andy Cartal informed the members that the required annual audit was performed by an audit committee and everything balanced out. He mentioned that anyone that is interested can have dual memberships in multiple chapters for \$9. Secretary Greg Chontow then mentioned that everyone should have received minutes from last meetings and additional ones were provided for those who didn't. Upon request for a motion to accept the minutes, John Kovach mentioned that a correction may need to be made in reference to the Boards continuing education requirements. John believes that the allowance of the same course and instructor was only for the 10 hour requirement and not for the additional 24 hours. No one had an answer for that, so Andy said that would be checked and the membership would be notified, and a correction would be made if necessary. Officer Don Storms thanked the membership for the fruit basket during his recovery from surgery. Vice President Bob Moentenich said that March 7th, the I-codes were fully in affect. He proceeded to tell us where the residential International Energy Code affects us. Some of the highlights were pools: heaters shall have a timer and power switch; if the heater is electric, we are to enforce the pool cover requirement. 50% of all bulbs in a dwelling shall be high efficiency lamps. Penetrations in the thermal envelope (Recessed luminaries and exterior outlet boxes) shall be sealed. Greg Chontow then talked about an article in Municipality Magazine, keeping in mind that plan review shall be completed in 20 business days and resubmissions in 7 business days. Any email correspondence is public records, and a hard copy should be filed. There was a reminder that annual pool inspections are coming up. DCA published a model inspection notice for inspectors to send to pool operators. The meeting was then handed over to John Cangemi from UL. John gave a lively demonstration on Types AC and MC cables. He presented the different physical characteristics of the two cables, and its application as allowed in the NEC. The meeting concluded at 9:15 with a round of applause and great thanks to John.
